Andalusia

Located 13 miles upstream from central Philadelphia in Bucks County, Andalusia has been the country estate of the Craig and Biddle families for more than 200 years. 🌿 The centerpiece is the Greek Revival house with its monumental columned porch. The “Big House”, as it is known, is furnished in a variety of American period styles. 🌿 The estate grounds contain a number of other architectural features: the Billiard Room (1815, 1827, and 1835), a Gothic Grotto (1834-1836), the Cottage (1838 and 1852) and numerous outbuildings. Within the gardens, the Graperies are perhaps Andalusia’s most interesting relic from the past. Remaining from an ambitious attempt at commercial grape growing in the mid 1800’s, two enormous masonry walls today enclose a formal garden and have been partially restored to show their original agricultural purpose.
